During the Philadelphia Open Studio Tours • East of Broad Street • October 11-12, 2008

InLiquid, Philadelphia Center for the Book, Philagrafika, and The Print Center will host the Open Portfolio to support individual artist printmakers, photographers and book artists in the Philadelphia region whose studios cannot accommodate public visitation. This event will provide a venue for more than 30 individual artists during the weekend of October 11-12, 2008 as part of the citywide Philadelphia Open Studio Tours, to showcase their fine art prints, photographs and artists books to the public in an art fair setting. Each participating artist will be given a table to display his or her work for the public from noon to 6 pm on Saturday and Sunday at the Crane Arts Building, 1400 N. American St., Philadelphia, PA 19122.

- Join more than 30 professional artists for an open portfolio event during the POST weekend (Philadelphia Open Studio Tours).
- Invite the public to see your artwork on October 11-12; share your artwork with art lovers and collectors from Philadelphia and throughout the region.
- Meet fellow artists and work together to make Philadelphia a destination for the printed image.

Info for Participants

- Open to current artist members of the above organizations. Artists working in traditional and experimental print media (including photography) are welcome, but the opportunity is open only to artists without an accessible Philadelphia studio, who thus are not eligible to participate as a full POST studio.
- Table space is limited and is available on a first come, first served basis.
- The \$35 registration fee covers:
 - Open Portfolio postcard supply (each artist will receive 50 cards)
 - Open Portfolio web listing with hyperlinks to artist web sites & short artist bio
 - 6 foot table (please bring table cover)

Event Marketing

- InLiquid, the Philadelphia Center for the Book, Philagrafika, and The Print Center have registered the Open Portfolio event as a POST site and together they have placed a full-page ad to market the Open Portfolio event in the POST Directory, which includes participating artists list.
